Dates: June 24 & 25, 2017; provided that additional relays may be added if the number of preregistrations warrants.

Eligibility: This match is open to all competitors. Membership in the NRA or FRGC is not required.

Entries: Competitors may preregister by using either the attached Match Entry Form or a standard NRA SR-1 form, accompanied by payment of the entry fee. Entry fees may be paid using NRA award points or a check or money order made payable to "Fairfax Rod & Gun Club" (match fees for each match must be paid by a separate check). Preregistration forms and entry fees must be received not later than the Wednesday preceding the match. Post entries will be accepted at the range each day until 15 minutes prior to the match start time, to the extent that firing positions remain available. This match is limited to 25 competitors per day, and will each be conducted in a single relay on each day. Preregistration forms and entry fees should be mailed to John Hollingshead at P.O. Note – All match fees are waived for junior competitors who are accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Checks or Money Orders Must be Made Payable to "Fairfax Rod & Gun Club".

Rules: Current NRA Pistol Rules for precision pistol competitions will govern the state championship match and the distinguished revolver match. Current CMP rules will govern the excellence-in-competition matches.

Classification: The NRA classification system for precision pistol competitions will be used, including Rule 19.6 (assigned classifications for shooters with classifications in related NRA pistol events). Individuals who have not been classified will fire in the Master Class. Competitors must provide proof of classification upon request.

Divisions; .22-Only Competitors: Competitors may elect to shoot in any division (Open, Metallic, or Production) by so notifying the Match Director prior to the commencement of the 2700 match. Any competitor who does not otherwise so notify the Match Director of such election shall compete in the

Open division. Scores fired in all divisions will be combined for awards purposes. Competitors may also elect to shoot only .22 caliber guns during the entire 2700 match by so notifying the Match Director prior to the commencement of the 2700 match.

EIC Matches: Both service pistol and .22 rimfire pistol EIC matches will be conducted each day. Competitors may elect to compete in either or both such EIC matches.

Firing Position Assignments: At the discretion of the Match Director, firing positions may be assigned, and competitors will be notified of their firing positions when they sign in at the range on the day of the match.

Awards: Awards will be given to the open winners in each of the 16 matches comprising the state championship. A first place award will be given in each class for each match provided that there are at least 5 competitors in the class. A second place award will be given if there are at least 10 competitors in the class, and a third place award will be given if there are at least 15 competitors in the class. Competitors who elect to shoot only .22 caliber guns during the entire 2700 match as provided above will be in an awards category separate from all other competitors, will not be eligible for open or class awards, and will be not eligible for any awards unless at least 5 competitors shoot .22 only. Awards will be forwarded to winners by check, cash, or NRA award points.

Time of first match: Firing will commence each day promptly at **9:00 A.M.**

Match Schedule:

These are one-day 2700 matches with a single relay each day.

.22 Caliber Matches

- Match 1 Slow Fire match, 50 yards
- Match 2 National Match Course
- Match 3 Timed Fire Match, 25 yards
- Match 4 Rapid Fire Match, 25 yards

Center Fire Matches

- Match 6 Slow Fire match, 50 yards
- Match 7 National Match Course
- Match 8 Timed Fire Match, 25 yards
- Match 9 Rapid Fire Match, 25 yards

.45 Caliber Matches

- Match 11 Slow Fire match, 50 yards
- Match 12 National Match Course
- Match 13 Timed Fire Match, 25 yards
- Match 14 Rapid Fire Match, 25 yards

Aggregate Matches (not fired)

- Match 5 Aggregate of matches 1 through 4
- Match 10 Aggregate of matches 6 through 9
- Match 15 Aggregate of matches 11 through 14
- Match 16 Aggregate of matches 5, 10, & 15 (Grand Aggregate)

EIC and DR Matches

Two or three National Match Courses will be fired each day after the completion of Match 14.

Match Conditions: Scoring will be done down range. Competitors will pass scorecards to the right and score the target to their left, except that a range officer will score the last target on the high end of the range. Competitors will be responsible for repairing their own targets. A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge as to the score of a target. A 3-person jury designated by the Chief Range Officer will render final decisions on any challenge. **Competitors must provide and wear eye and ear protection.** Competitors must also provide their own staplers, staples, and pasties or tape. Violations of NRA or club rules, or good safety practices, will result in the competitor's removal from the range and forfeiture of fees.

Range Facilities: Lunch is available for an additional charge at the clubhouse near the entrance gate. Sanitary facilities are available at the range and at the clubhouse.

Directions to the Range: The Club is located at 7039 Signal Hill Road in Manassas, Virginia.

From I-66, take Rt. 28 south to Liberia Avenue; turn left onto Liberia Avenue and proceed about 1.5 miles east to Signal Hill Road; turn left on Signal Hill Road and proceed approximately 3 miles to the Club.

From I-95, take exit 158B (Prince William County Parkway) and proceed west approximately 12 miles to Ellis Road; turn right on Ellis Road (becomes Signal Hill Road) and proceed approximately 1 mile to the Club.
