Subj: MATCH DIRECTOR'S WELCOME

Welcome to 58<sup>th</sup> Annual Atlantic Fleet and All Navy (East) Matches 2019! The Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) rules for service rifle and service pistol continue to evolve. We will continue to modify our program to incorporate the changes that supersede Navy Instructions. For Excellence in Competition matches, we will adhere to OPNAVINST 3590.26 guidance and award medals to the top 10 percent of eligible Sailors. This instruction is being reviewed for change to improve our program; more to follow on this important issue. Our goal during these matches is to provide you with a premiere training and competition experience so you depart with a stronger sense of confidence and competence in small arms marksmanship.

If you are a new shooter (first time attending a Bullseye Pistol or High Power Service Rifle competition), this first phase is for you. The Fleet phase is focused on supporting the new shooter. It is designed to take a Sailor who enjoys shooting and impart basic and advance skillsets of the fundamentals in marksmanship. We will accomplish this through mentorship; assigning an experienced shooter with the new shooter to help guide them and show them the way. The new shooter will attend a pistol and rifle Small Arms Firing School (SAFS) prior to conducting live fire events. Sailors must train with an open mind. Listen to your mentors. Ask a lot of questions. For the civilian friends that join us on the range, please share your knowledge and experience. These matches are geared toward training new Navy shooters. Your patience is expected and greatly appreciated.

During Fleet phase, commands are encouraged to field rifle and pistol teams. Team rules are promulgated in this bulletin. A team consists of four shooters. If you can get three shooters from the same command, you can compete as an official command team (we will assign a fourth shooter to complete the 4-person team). Awards are given to the top three large command and top three small command teams in both rifle and pistol, and a large trophy is given to the overall first place official Navy team which they will take back to their command for the year.

During the All Navy phase, everyone should have a stronger working knowledge of line commands, shooting positions and range operations; hence there are no "New Shooters" in this phase. The line is expected to move quicker and time management by the shooter becomes more important. Be prepared to execute that day's schedule. During the All Navy match, the top active and reserve shooters will compete to determine All Navy honors between East and West Coast. While shot on different dates, the same course of fire is used, thus providing comparable results to award the All Navy Team Trophy as well as "bragging rights." Upon completion of the All Navy match, the official 2019 Navy Rifle and Pistol teams will be determined for Active and Reserve and will be announced with a formal letter and possibly with a naval message. The individuals named will represent the Navy at the Inter Service and National matches. I must emphasize that the purpose of the All Navy match is to support higher level competition. Your match fees, your efforts, and the efforts of the staff are all geared towards fielding and improving the "Big Navy" team. Remember that the Camp Perry National Pistol Record is still held by Petty Officer 1<sup>st</sup> Class Don Hamilton, the 1979 Long Range Rifle Champion was ETC Michael Gorchinski, and the 2014 National Trophy Individual (rifle) Champion was CDR Matthew Bartel. The development and success of Navy shooting in the future depends on the effort and resources we devote today.

The Navy Marksmanship Team has and will continue to operate due to the hard work, perseverance, and professionalism of a small group of dedicated individuals. Some are very senior (in both time-in-service and paygrade) and many are retired. To ensure the continued success, conduct and expansion of the Navy matches, find an aspect of the matches that you enjoy and pitch in and help out. The "Match Staff" is constantly looking for new participants with strong leadership skills. Our program relies completely on an all-volunteer staff.

Pending superceding Navy instructions, the current National Rifle Association (NRA) High Power Rifle and Conventional Pistol Rules, and the current Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) rules will govern the conduct of our matches. The match director has final say on rule issues.

**Location:** Weapons Training Battalion, Ranges 3, 4 and the Competition Pistol Range at Marine Corps Base Quantico are located on Garand Rd, Quantico Virginia (N38.531, W077.434). Camp Upshur Barracks are located on Bonnyman St, Nokesville, VA (N38.63, W77.53).

**Directions:** The Calvin A. Lloyd Range Complex is located on Marine Corps Base Quantico. From Interstate Highway-95, take Exit # 148. Turn west and follow the road 3.9 miles to the Weapons Training Battalion Complex on the right. At the gate all weapons must be CASED and UNLOADED. The CASE must not be readily accessible. Ammo must be separate from the case and not readily accessible. Magazines must be unloaded. If searched, you should declare that you are transporting unloaded, encased firearms to the ranges for competition shooting, and show them your orders. Registration is at building 27215, on the competition pistol range (Match Headquarters).

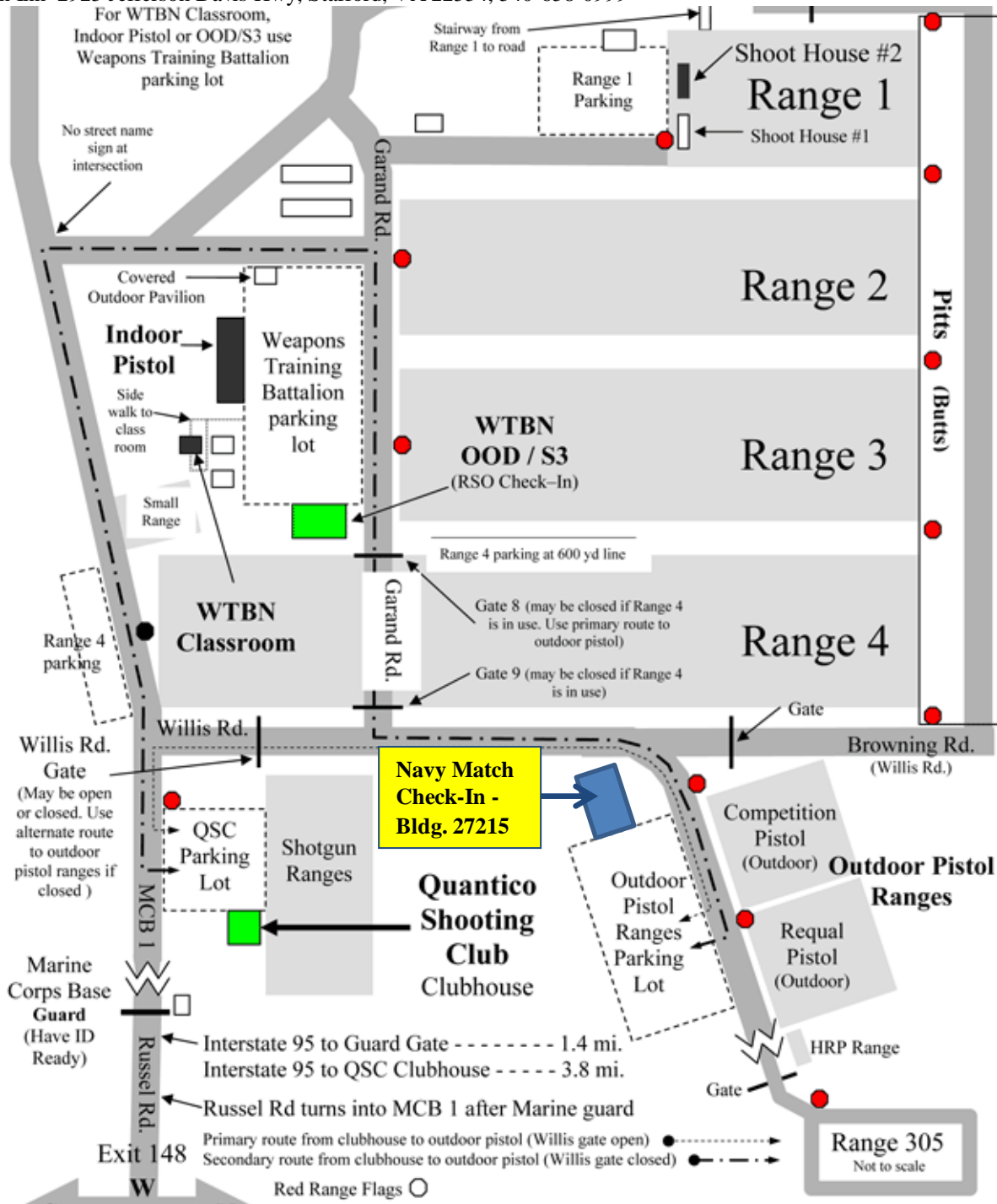
**Initial Check-In:** Upon arrival, report to building 27215 to register, confirm payment, receive scorecards/stickers and billeting instructions. All weapons are required to have a Limited Technical Inspection (LTI) before any live fire participation in the Fleet or All Navy matches. This is a safety inspection during which all triggers will be weighed. Gear issue for rifle matches will occur at the pistol range. Quantities are limited, and gear is issued on first come/first served basis (gear issue time and location will be announced at registration). Please check in Friday afternoon, if possible. This will make things go much smoother Saturday morning. Welcome aboard and safety brief will be held on the competition pistol range bleachers (Parking Lot) at 0800 on Saturday.

**Billeting:** We will have open bay barracks at Camp Upshur for active/reserve/retirees at no charge that consists of two, 50-man, bunk-bed, and open bay, Quonset huts with heating/air conditioning and detached heads. Competitors are required to bring bedding/sleeping bag. No consumable items are provided (TP, trash bags, etc.). Vertical wall lockers may be available. Competitors are encouraged to bring a foot locker or other secure storage. Carpooling and a parking pass will be required at

Camp Upshur, as limited parking spaces are available. While at Camp Upshur, parking is NOT allowed on the large "grinder" (paved area behind Quonset huts, used for driver training and medevac), or in 4th LAR parking lot. Reveille will be 1 hour before morning muster, and taps at 2200. Travel time from Camp Upshur to Range 3 is approximately 25 minutes. The speed limit on the road to Camp Upshur (MCB-1) is 45 MPH. All competitors staying at Camp Upshur will sign a page 13 delineating your responsibilities. **Alcohol is prohibited at Camp Upshur.** Any violations at Camp Upshur will result in the individual being directed to leave the matches.

**Open to:** The LANTFLT and All Navy (East) Championships are open to both Military and Civilian shooters, up to the range limit of 200 (4 relays). Range priority will be in the following order:

1. Navy Active Duty/ Reserves
2. Navy Retired
3. Other Service Active Duty/Reserves
4. Other Service Retired
5. Civilians shooting the entire week
6. All others

Note 1: During any given calendar year, an individual may only compete in one Fleet match (either coast) and if qualified (or at discretion of match director), one All Navy match (either coast). For example, an individual may compete at the PACFLT matches and the All Navy (East) Matches, but may not compete at both the All Navy (West) and All Navy (East) matches. This restriction holds for all phases of the championships: individual, team, and Excellence In Competition (EIC) matches.

Note 2: Civilians (including retirees) are only permitted to shoot in one military EIC match for record per year. If you are shooting both Fleet and All Navy matches, the Fleet EIC match will be counted as your record match. The match format will administratively contain both an EIC match and a NMC, with awards for the combined matches (i.e. if you are not shooting for leg points, you will be scored under the NMC match, keeping in line with CMP rules that you may not shoot an EIC match “out of competition”).



Registration Fees: Each competitor will pay \$50 per competition (Fleet or All Navy) or portion thereof. In other words, whether you shoot one match or all of Fleet or All Navy, the fee is \$50.

If you are unable to attend after paying, you will be issued a refund. Mail-in entries must be received by 03 May 2019. PayPal entries must be received by 08 May 2019. **To maximize efficiency for our first day at the range, we ask that all shooters register and pay in advance, prior to arriving at MCBQ. Match staff plans to be on site at 1600 on Friday, 10 May for early check-ins.**

Payment will secure your registration for the matches in the order received. DD2760 (Qualification to Possess Firearms or Ammunition), civilian hold-harmless, and billeting Page 13 will be completed at the registration desk during match check-in.

#### **Military Orders:**

Only individual orders will be accepted. Group orders will not be accepted as they do not allow the Match Director to select outstanding individual marksmen for higher competition (All Navy). Individuals attending the Matches under orders are required to be present for the entire period of the orders (exceptions require approval of the Match Director).

The following statements shall be written into all original orders: (As Required)

1. Report to the Match Director (LANT) Rifle and Pistol Matches at Weapons Training Battalion, Marine Corps Base Quantico, VA. If qualified and selected for further competition, you will proceed to such additional places as directed by competent authority for the All Navy Rifle and Pistol Championships.
2. Transporting weapons: You are permitted to transport weapons/firearms for use in competition and training IAW the Gun Control Act of 1968, title 18, Chapter 44, Section 926A.

**Travel:** Travel and per diem costs are the responsibility of the individual competitor. Commands are highly encouraged to sponsor costs for Individuals/Teams for this military event.

  - NRA Classification is not required for CMP Matches, NRA Classification is required for NRA Matches.
  - Competitors’ packages are obtained from the NRA, competitions department.
  - Sailors traveling on Funded or Cost Orders must attend SAFS as a coach.
  - Sailors with EIC points: do not Sign up for SAFS. You will be a coach, not a firing member.
  - **Advance Registration, (Current USNMT Application) must be on file with Rifle OIC, (TBD), Team fees will be paid by the USNMT.**
  - The Nationals barracks at Camp Perry will be available. USNMT will have 50 racks (two bays) for male, 9 racks for female, tentatively for even distribution of Active and Reserve. Let the Higher Team OICs know your intentions and needs for a barracks space soonest - first come first served. Be advised this is open bay style, plan ahead for bringing toiletries and to help with routine clean-up of the spaces and nightly lights out NLT 2200.
