In an effort to accomplish this mission, all shooters, active and retired, are asked to search their deepest recesses for old match records that can be loaned for scanning to the Archive, which stands, as of February 2008, at 1.02 GB of information. In particular, many match bulletins from Fleet and All-Navy for the years 1950 through 1981, whole or in part, are urgently sought. Please be a contributor. Call or send an e-mail with event dates if you hold records for this time frame. We need contributions from everyone in order to reach our ambitious goal. Additionally, the archive includes annotated photos of shooters and events. Your pictures provide a personal touch to the archive, so feel free to send them along as well.
