1. In accordance with reference (a), the East Coast Navy Excellence in Competition (Leg) Matches were conducted on the small arms ranges at Naval Station Annapolis, MD on 7 & 8 July, 1984. The matches were held to provide an opportunity to compete for leg points, for those Navy shooters who trained this past year for the fleet matches yet were ineligible to fire in the Atlantic Fleet Rifle and Pistol Championships.

2. The weather was generally warm and dry. The first morning was slightly overcast during the pistol firing and was clear and bright by the afternoon. There were no delays or rescheduling because of weather.

3. CONDITIONS GOVERNING MATCHES:

a) Rules: This match was governed by the rules prescribed by the National Board for the promotion of rifle practice as stated in reference (b).

b) Open to: Any citizen of the United States 16 years of age or older. Priority for squadding as follows:

- Active USN
- Reserve USN
- Retired USN
- Active USA, USAF, USMC, USCG
- Other Reserve Components and National Guard
- All Others

All entries were excepted and squadded both days.

c) Course of fire: National Match Course
Rifle - Two times through course

First Stage - Slow fire, 200 yards, 20 shots, standing, 1 minute per shot.

Second Stage - Sustained fire, 200 yards, 10 shots, sitting or kneeling from standing, 60 seconds.

Third Stage - Sustained fire, 300 yards, 10 shots, prone from standing, 70 seconds

Fourth Stage - Slow fire, 500 yards with reduced target, 20 shots, prone, 1 minute per shot.

Pistol - Two times through course

First Stage - Slow fire, 50 yards, 10 shots, 1 min per shot (scoring after 10 shots)

Second Stage - Timed fire, 25 yards, 2-5 round strings, 20 seconds each string (scoring after 10 shots).

Third Stage - Rapid fire, 25 yards, 2-5 round strings, 10 seconds each string (scoring after 10 shots).

d) Arms: US Rifle caliber .30ml/minm; US Rifle caliber 7.62mm M1/NM; US Rifle caliber 7.62mm M14M/M14NM; Springfield Armory C. Rifle caliber 7.62mm M1A, having not less than 4½ pound trigger pull, with standard stock and sights as issued, or the US Rifle caliber 5.56mm M16 series or commercial equivalent, as prescribed for use in the National Matches. Heavy barrels authorized for .30-06 and 7.62 rifles only.

Pistol, US caliber .45 M1911 or M1911A1 having not less than 4 pound trigger pull, as prescribed for use in the National Matches.

e) Ammunition: All ammunition issued on the firing line. No other ammunition authorized on the line.

Rifle - service grade 147gr ball for 200 yards and 173gr match grade for 300 yards and 500 yards.

Pistol - service grade caliber .45


