Location: Weapons Training Battalion, Ranges 2, 3, 4 and the Competition Pistol Range at Marine Corps Base Quantico are located on Garand Rd, Quantico Virginia (N38.531, W077.434).

Directions: The Calvin A. Lloyd Range Complex is located on Marine Corps Base Quantico. From Interstate Highway-95, take Exit # 148. Turn west and follow the road 3.9 miles to the Weapons Training Battalion Complex on the right. At the gate all weapons must be CASED and UNLOADED. The CASE

must not be readily accessible. Ammo must be separate from the case and not readily accessible. Magazines must be unloaded. If searched, you should declare that you are transporting unloaded, encased firearms to the ranges for competition shooting, and show them your orders. Registration will be conducted at the Pistol Range Stat Shack.

Initial Check-In: Upon arrival, report to the building located at the Pistol Range Stat Shack to register (can be found on map below), confirm payment, and to receive scorecards/stickers. All weapons **shall** have a Limited Technical Inspection (LTI) before any live fire participation in the Fleet or All Navy matches. The LTI ensure that weapons are safe to operate and conform to match standards. For shooters who do not have all of the specialized competition gear for rifle competition, there are limited quantities available for use and will be issued on first come/first served basis (gear issue time and location will be announced at registration). **Please check in Friday afternoon, if possible.** This will make things go much smoother Saturday morning. The safety brief will be held on the competition pistol range bleachers (Parking Lot) at 0700 on Saturday.

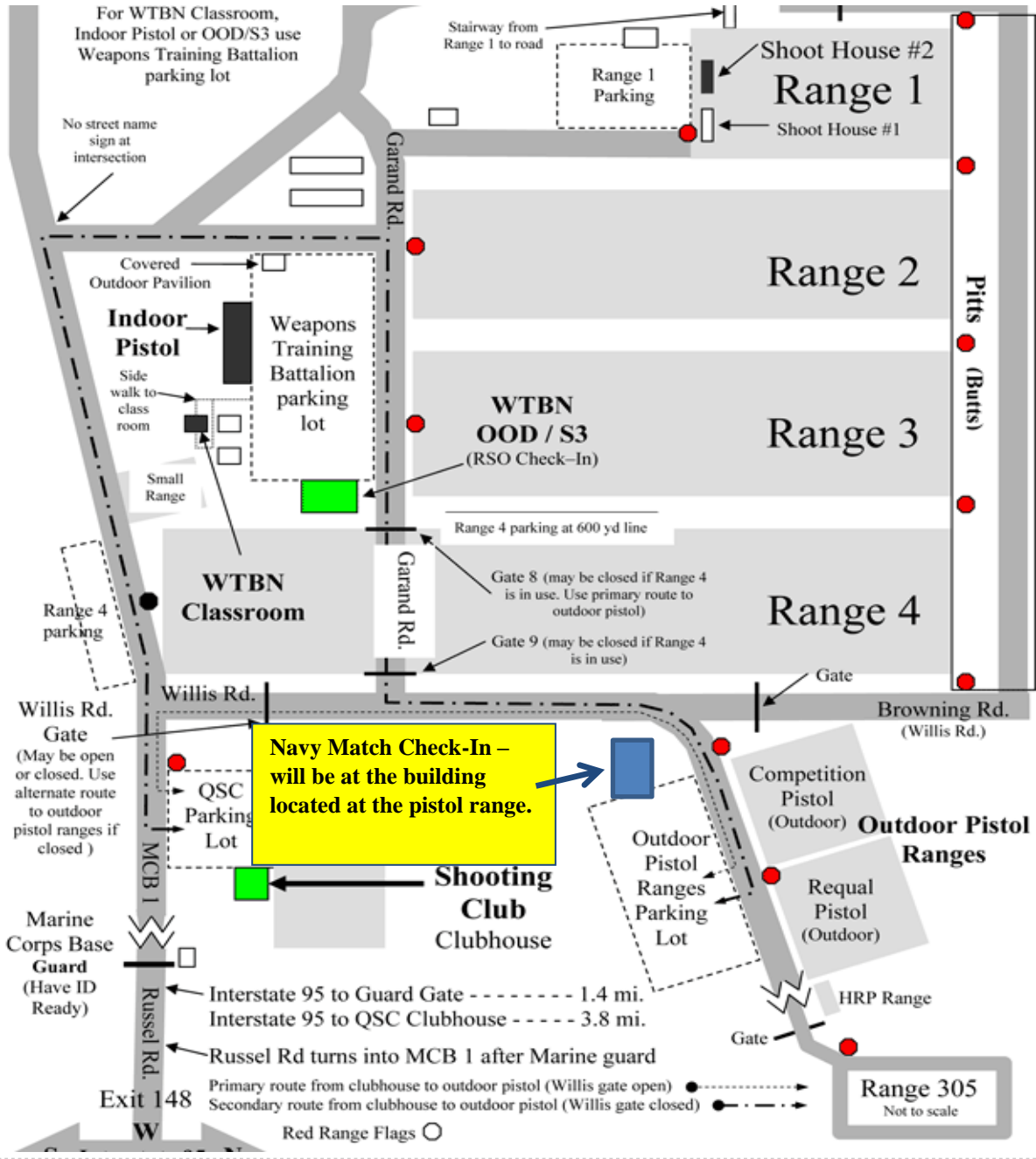

Notes:

1) To shoot the 1,000-yard-Long Range Match you must shoot a score of 175 or better at the 600 yard line in any previous match during this week. Firing 5.56MM at 1000 yards will be approved on an individual basis by the Match Director. 5.56 Navy Team rifles with iron sights will not be allowed. If you are not “on paper” within 10 shots, you will be removed from the firing line. Match will consist of 1000 yard Slow Fire Prone, 20 shots for record and unlimited sighters in 30 minutes

Open to: The LANTFLT and All Navy (East) Championships are open to both Military and Civilian shooters, up to the range limit of about 200 (4 relays). Range priority will be in the following order:

1. Navy Active Duty/ Reserves
2. Navy Retired
3. Other Service Active Duty/Reserves
4. Other Service Retired
5. Civilians shooting the entire week
6. All others

Note 1:

During any given calendar year, an individual may only compete in one Fleet match (either coast) and if qualified (or at discretion of match director), one All Navy match (either coast). For example, an individual may compete at the PACFLT matches and the All Navy (East) Matches, but may not

compete at both the All Navy (West) and All Navy (East) matches. This restriction holds for all phases of the championships: individual, team, and Excellence In Competition (EIC) matches.

Note 2:

Civilians (not including retirees) are only permitted to shoot in one military EIC match for record per year. If you are shooting both Fleet and All Navy matches, the All Navy EIC match will be counted as your record match. The match format will administratively contain both an EIC match and a NMC, with awards for the combined matches (i.e. if you are not shooting for leg points, you will be scored under the NMC match, keeping in line with CMP rules that you may not shoot an EIC match “out of competition”). **You must DECLARE AT CHECK IN if you do not wish to be “in competition” for EIC points in any match.**

Registration Fees: Each competitor will pay \$50 per competition (pistol or rifle) or portion thereof. In other words, whether you shoot one match or all of a match (rifle or pistol), the fee is \$50. The .22 EIC match is a separate match from the pistol matches so a separate fee applies. If you are registered for the full pistol phase, the .22 EIC fee is \$15. If only shooting the .22 EIC match, the fee is \$25.00. A shooter wishing to participate in ALL matches during the week will pay \$115.

Registration: Registration will occur online via the CMP website (www.odcmp.com). Check the team website (www.usnmt.org) for the link. Payment can be made either via PayPal to usnshooting@gmail.com or via mail to Robert Ryan, 232 Royal Oak Dr, Chesapeake, VA, 23322. Payments may be made with check or PayPal only or cash or credit card at check in. Please do not send a money order. Make checks out to “USNST”. Please pay in advance if at all possible. If you are unable to attend after paying, you will be issued a refund. Mail-in entries must be received by **15 April 2024**. PayPal entries must be received by **21 April 2024**. **To maximize efficiency for our first day at the range, we ask that all shooters register and pay in advance, prior to arriving at MCBQ. Match staff plans to be on site at 1200 on Friday, 10 May for early check-ins.**

Payment will secure your registration for the matches in the order received. DD2760 (Qualification to Possess Firearms or Ammunition), and civilian hold-harmless documentation will be completed at the registration desk during match check-in.

Military Orders:

Only individual orders will be accepted. Group orders will not be accepted as they do not allow the Match Director to select outstanding individual marksmen for higher competition (All Navy). Individuals attending the Matches under orders are required to be present for the entire period of the orders (exceptions require approval of the Match Director).

The following statements shall be written into all original orders: (As Required)

1. Report to the Match Director (LANT) Rifle and Pistol Matches at Weapons Training Battalion, Marine Corps Base Quantico, VA. If qualified and selected for further

competition, you will proceed to such additional places as directed by competent authority for the All Navy Rifle and Pistol Championships.

2. Transporting weapons: You are permitted to transport weapons/firearms for use in competition and training IAW the Gun Control Act of 1968, title 18, Chapter 44, Section 926A.

Travel: Travel and per diem costs are the responsibility of the individual competitor. Commands are highly encouraged to sponsor costs for Individuals/Teams for this military event.

D. THIS PREMIERE MARKSMANSHIP EVENT SERVES TO TRAIN SAILORS AND SELECT THE BEST NAVY RIFLE AND PISTOL COMPETITORS TO REPRESENT THE NAVY AT JOINT SERVICE AND NATIONAL MATCHES. THE MATCHES ADHERE TO THE SAFETY AND BASIC MARKSMANSHIP GUIDELINES CONTAINED WITHIN REFS A THROUGH C. THE MATCH CONDUCT AND EXCELLENCE IN COMPETITION (EIC) RULES ARE GOVERNED BY REF D. THE COMPETITIVE MATCH FORMAT PROVIDES A SAFE ENVIRONMENT THAT FOSTERS HEALTHY COMPETITION AND PRESENTS A UNIQUE TRAINING ENVIRONMENT TO INVEST IN OUR SAILORS, PROVIDE FUNDAMENTAL AND ADVANCED MARKSMANSHIP SKILLS, AND FOSTER A MORE LETHAL FORCE.

2. PER REF A, COMMANDING OFFICERS ARE AUTHORIZED TO FUND THEIR SAILORS' PARTICIPATION IN THIS ADVANCED MARKSMANSHIP TRAINING EVENT. PER REF E, INDIVIDUALS WITH A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CONVICTION ARE NOT

AUTHORIZED TO PARTICIPATE.

3. COMPETITORS MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE INDIVIDUAL RIFLE OR PISTOL PHASES OR BOTH. ALL ACTIVE DUTY, RESERVE, MIDSHIPMEN, RETIRED SAILORS, AND COMPETITORS FROM OTHER SERVICES MAY PARTICIPATE. INDIVIDUALS MAY ATTEND EITHER THE EAST OR WEST COAST MATCHES, BUT NOT BOTH. INTERSTATE TRANSPORTATION OF FIREARMS FOR USE IN COMPETITION AND TRAINING MUST COMPLY WITH THE GUN CONTROL ACT OF 1968, TITLE 18, CHAPTER 44, SECTION 926A AS WELL AS ANY LAW, RULE, OR REGULATION OF THE STATE OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THEREOF THROUGH WHICH THE MEMBER IS TRAVELING. ADDITIONALLY, INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION OF FIREARMS MUST COMPLY WITH TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION REGULATIONS AND THOSE OF THE FOREIGN COUNTRY THROUGH WHICH THE MEMBER IS TRAVELING.

5. MATCH AMMUNITION AND SHOOTING EQUIPMENT WILL BE AVAILABLE. LIMITED MATCH GRADE RIFLES AND PISTOLS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR SERVICE MEMBERS. SEASONED AND EXPERIENCED COMPETITORS ARE ENCOURAGED TO BRING ANY EXTRA EQUIPMENT TO SUPPORT AND MENTOR NEW SHOOTERS. COMPETITORS MAY BRING THEIR OWN SAFE AMMUNITION FOR USE IN THEIR PERSONAL WEAPONS PER REF D.

THE U.S. NAVY MARKSMANSHIP TEAM HOME PAGE PROVIDES MATCH PROGRAMS FOR EACH COAST WITH INFORMATION ON ELIGIBILITY, REGISTRATION, CHECK-IN, REPORTING PROCEDURES, EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS, SECURITY, POINTS OF CONTACT AND OTHER INFORMATION.
